4.1 IREE – Steve Amstutz

Discussion

- 8th year working with Glendale, collecting a lot of survey information and student outcome data
- Sharing a few highlights from the surveys from this year
- 82% of students grades 3-12 took the survey
- Optimal Academic Confidence was up to 46% this year and the Academic Confidence Risk went down to 18% - students felt more confident in their academic success and fewer students felt less confident in their academic success – confidence can also waver from time to time, especially when introducing the college courses
- At the Elementary School level, Optimal Academic Engagement went up to 81% with the risk scoring at 7%
- At the High School level, Optimal High Expectations went up to 70% with the risk scoring at 3%

- Supports for Educators surveys for Optimal Classroom Visits went up to 32% with the risk scoring at 47% - the biggest takeaway is that although educators feel that there could be more visits to assist with instructional improvement, there was a score of 100% saying that feedback was given in a timely manner and was valuable to improving instruction
- Educator Optimal Confidence about being able to succeed with all of their students went up to 60% with the risk dropping down to 15%
- Standards for Practice and Outcomes showed a growth of 55% stating that there are clear standards of teachers' practices in and outside of the classroom with 35% stating that there are clear expectations for students' academic performance.
- Overall, the trend is going in a very positive direction
